2		Minutes of June 3, 2024, were tabled. Motion #168 Ed Dyke/ Irene Stack Proposed to accept minutes of June 3, 2024. All in favor, motion carried.

6		David and Betty Doyle requested to speak to council regarding the infrastructure issues that they are having around their home at 97 Main Road, Petty Harbour.
		Mrs. Doyle spoke about her concerns regarding the lack of maintenance to the infrastructure in the area. She noted that the 3 manholes are all clogged with sand and debris. She noted that her driveway in falling in and there are sinkholes
		developing on the property. She believes that this is caused by the roadway sinking. MHA Loyola O'Driscoll visited her property this past weekend and will bring her concerns to the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Minister.
		Staff will get in contact with their contact at the department also to see if he can visit the area. The foreman will get pictures of the problem areas to have on file.
7		Application (A2024-24) for an approval in principle to operate a tourist accommodation business at 61 Long Run Road. A notice was sent to the public for comment. There were no comments or concerns received. The accommodation
		must be registered with the provincial government before a permit is issued by the town. Motion # 171 Ed Dyke/ Irene Stack
		Proposed to approve the tourist accommodation application in principle (A2024-24). The applicant must register with the Government NL before a permit is issued by the town. All in favor, motion carried.
8		St. Joseph's Storyboard. Members of the Storyboard Committee, Recreation and Council met onsite and have all agreed with the proposed location of the storyboard.
		Motion # 172 David Balsom/ Ed Dyke Proposed to approve the location of the Storyboard. All in favor. Motion carried.
9		Request for Donation from Jacob Stack who will be travelling to Quebec for the NL Under 17 Selects Softball.

		Proposed to donate \$100 to Jacob Stack, as he is travelling outside the province and meets the criteria for the town's donation policy. All in favor. Motion carried.
10		"Caution- Autistic Child In area" sign request on Long Run Road. Staff were in contact with the Autism Society who advise not to erect a sign that stated this. They noted that it could possibly make a vulnerable person more vulnerable. They recommended erecting a sign that states "Caution, Children at Play". This gets a very similar message across- to use caution. Motion # 174 Ed Dyke/ David Balsom Proposed to purphase and creek a sign for Long Purp Road that states "Caution".
		Proposed to purchase and erect a sign for Long Run Road that states "Caution, Children at Play" and to purchase and replace the "Special Needs" sign on Long Run Road with the same message. All in favor, motion carried.
11		Requests from Recreation Commission to have gates fixed, new garbage box installed, waterspout moved, water pipe made safer, clean up behind chalet, and class A stone installed around edges of pavement at the ballfield. Deputy Mayor Raymond advised that he would move the water spout at the ballfield. A new garbage box has been purchased for the ballfield. Motion #175 Irene Stack & Ed Dyke Proposed that staff will get gates repaired, water pipe cut, and clean up behind the chalet. Staff will also get a quote on installing class A stone around the edges of
		the pavement. All in favor, motion carried. Recreations request for extra funding.
		Motion #176 Irene Stack/ Ed Dyke Proposed to defer this request until they receive a quote for the installation of fill around the pavement and they receive a breakdown from Recreation on what they plan on using their funds for. All in favor, motion carried.
12		2023 Audit- Consolidated Financial Statements Motion 177 Ed Dyke/ David Balsom Proposed to approve the 2023 Audit- Consolidated Financial Statements. All in favor, motion carried.
13		Chromebooks Motion # 178 Irene Stack/ Agatha Stack-Balsom Proposed to defer the purchase of Chromebooks for council until 2025 and have this expense added to the 2025 budget. All in favor, motion carried.

20		Councillor Dyke requested that the speedbumps be installed in the coming days, as the children will be out of school for the summer.
21		Deputy Mayor Raymond requested that the pilons be installed by Chafe's Landing as they were in previous years.
